

Widespread layoffs have also been witnessed in finance, retail, pharmacy and other sectors. Oil marketing companies hiked price of petrol. Price of domestics LPG pipeline gas, jet fuel also soared to multi-level high. The sharp rise in crude oil prices adversely impacted inflation India. The war led to fall in BSE Sensex& delayed IPO'S. The lesson for India is that a country with a weak military will be unable to defend itself against a technologically superior; the defence services must be loyal to the constitution rather than political party.
