

An introduction to the securities market and a discussion of the various forms of securities, such as stocks, bonds, and derivatives, were presented at the beginning of the seminar. Participants developed a better grasp of the roles that investors, traders, and intermediaries play on securities exchanges.



With a focus on options and futures contracts, participants learned about derivatives. The conference discussed the fundamentals of options trading, such as calls and puts, and the idea of futures contracts linked to commodities, currencies, and indices. Participants obtained knowledge about the use of derivatives for hedging and speculating in risk management. Leverage and counterparty risk were two other potential complications and risks of derivatives that were brought up. Various wealth-generation techniques were covered in the lecture. It was addressed how to find undervalued businesses using long-term investing, which is based on value investing ideas. It was investigated to see if growth investment could be used for businesses with strong growth potential. The idea of income investment,

with an emphasis on fixed-income securities and dividend stocks, was also put up as a way to build wealth. The idea of tactical asset allocation—adjusting portfolio allocation in response to market conditions—was emphasised as a flexible strategy for accumulating wealth.






prior training leading to confusion in effective use of the technology, slower internet speed, etc.



The speaker emphasised that the in online teaching teacher must use technology to enhance the course content, the students must do most of the work as more time students spend engaged with the content, the more they will learn. Everyone should strive for presence of social, cognitive and teaching. And above all to get started all we need is to have the basic computer skills and internet knowledge.

The teaching competencies must be to develop communication skills particularly in written communication. As in many programs teachers and students are communicating primarily through emails, discussion board and other texts. Also, time management skills are critical for both faculty and students.
